Umrah Visa Requirement

Please Check Mark The Following

- Original US Passports or copy of Green Card with home country Passport - Valid for 6 Months From Travel Start Date. **Green Card Copy Must Be Notarized**
- Passports for Green Card holders must show the recent entry stamp, If you have new passport should submit your old Passport with US entry stamp on it.
- Two color Passport size photo with **white background.**
- Original meningitis vaccination certificate.
- Saudi Visa Application filled out.
- The Pilgrims who have non-Islamic names must have a statement from any Islamic Center Showing Their Conversion To Islam
- For Ladies: a "Muhrem" must accompany the woman during the Hajj Trip if under the age of 45.
- Copy of Marriage certificate for ladies accompanying their husbands and copy of birth certificate for ladies accompanying their sons.
- Copy of Children's Birth Certificate if they are going with there parents, if children are only going with 1 Parent they must get a letter from other parent giving them permission to go. **letter must be notarized**
- Notarized letter of permission for ladies over 45 of age
- For Moroccan citizens who hold a green card, a letter of permission from the Moroccan Embassy In New York Is Needed To Be Able To Obtain the SAUDI VISA
- Please Include Return FedEx Envelope with Standard Overnight if you mail the passports

The Saudi Ministry of Hajj & Umrah Has imposed a UMRAH Visa Fees of SAR 2000(USD \$ 537.00) with immediate effect on those TRAVELER who have performed Umrah last 2-3 Hijri Years
